

AD HOC FEASIBILITY COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATIONS – MARCH 9, 2010

The Ad Hoc Feasibility Committee recommends that:

- 1a.** The attendance boundaries be changed for all elementary schools. Attached is a spreadsheet showing the new capacities including free and reduced lunch, minorities, as well as, map and list of streets.
- 1b.** In addition current 4th grade students will be allowed to stay at their current schools through the 2010-2011 school year as long as they provide their own transportation and inform the administration of their decision no later than June 30, 2010.
- 1c.** The Board of Education direct the Administration to meet with administrators and other appropriate parties and establish consistent plans for each school in welcoming students and parents to the new school configuration.

- 2.** The Board of Education establish a committee to continue a review of the JCJ Feasibility Study Report for future recommendations as they may apply to such items as a magnet school, disparities, facility development, etc.

- 3.** The Board of Education call a special meeting, with a public session, no later than March 23, 2010 to consider the recommendations of the Ad Hoc Feasibility Committee.
